Directions: Turn around and walk back down onto the High Street. Turn right onto Ironmonger's Street and up to Broad Street. Once there:

Cross the road and walk up the steps into Browne's Hospital. On the left is a stained glass window. What four pictures make up the window and the Browne's logo?

What year was Browne's Hospital founded?

10 The hotel here has a regal connection – what's it called?

Directions: Go across to All Saint's Church.

11 As you walk through the churchyard gate, what date do you walk across?

12 You step back in time near All Saint's but how do you know what time it is?

Directions: Look across to All Saint's Place and Red Lion Square.

13 On All Saints Place, what did the Millstone have, and when was it established?

14 Walk across Red Lion Square. What does Dawson's of Stamford sell?

Directions: Cross the road and walk up the High Street

15 Can you find and name the continents shown on Lloyds TSB bank?

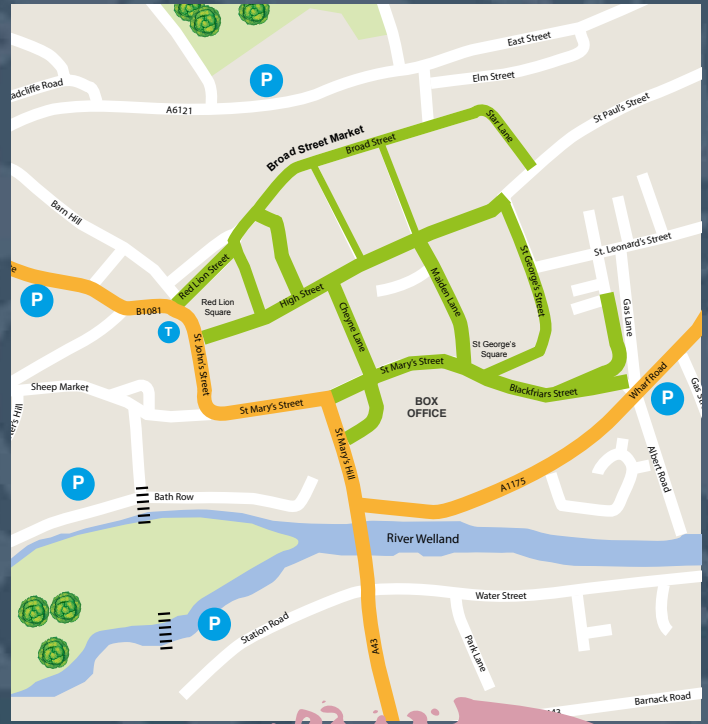
16 Which bookshop has the mock Tudor façade?

Directions: Turn around and walk back down High Street. Then turn left onto St John's Street

17 St John's Church is now run by whom?

Directions Continue walking down St John's Street and round onto St Mary's Street
(don't forget to keep looking for your favourite window display!)

18	The Bridal Room on the corner has some cute cherubs – how many are there?
19	Continue walking down St Mary's Hill. Just before the bridge, you will see Robert Loomes' shop. What do they sell and what date is on Chameleon's building next door?
Directions: Turn around, walk back up the hill and turn right next to the Town Hall onto St Mary's Place. Walk around and back onto St Mary's turning right to go back to St George's Square.	
20	When was the theatre on St Mary's street built?
